


WHY HIGH SCHOOL IN TWO YEARS?

At Bard Academy, we believe the traditional American high school isn't for everyone. For too many students, the junior and senior years are less about learning and more about preparing for standardized tests and taking courses just because they look good on a college résumé. Like our partners in the successful Bard High School Early Colleges in New York, Newark, Cleveland, Baltimore, and New Orleans, Bard Academy provides an enriching high school experience while creating a seamless transition into college life and work, right when you are most ready for it.

OUR VISION OF A BETTER HIGH SCHOOL

At Bard Academy, your high school teachers are your future college professors. Ninety-five percent of our full-time professors have PhDs or the highest academic credential in their fields. Small class sizes make it possible for professors to provide young scholars with clear road maps for growth. Bard Academy students enter an in-depth program of mathematics and sciences, social sciences, English, world languages, and the visual and performing arts. Seminar-style classes encourage sharing, debate, and a lively exchange of ideas. Writing is at the heart of a Bard Academy education: our curriculum teaches clear writing as a means to exploring and arriving at new ideas.





OUR CAMPUS


Acres of fields and trails make Simon's Rock a beautiful place to study and learn. The Daniel Arts Center, a state-of-the-art facility on campus, is a cultural resource for students and the surrounding community, hosting internationally renowned artists and performers year-round. At the Fisher Science Center, you'll find research labs, a greenhouse, and community gardens. Swim, rock climb, and play at the Kilpatrick Athletic Center, or take the school shuttle to downtown Great Barrington, named "Best Small Town" by *Smithsonian* magazine for its food, arts, and culture. You and your family will enjoy exploring the Berkshires, famous for its ski slopes, hiking trails, museums, and shops. New York and Boston are less than three hours away.

AFTER THE ACADEMY: COLLEGE BEGINS

Simon's Rock is the first and only educational institution in the United States carrying students from the beginning of high school to the completion of a bachelor's degree in six years rather than the usual eight. Immediately following the 10th grade, you'll enter Bard College at Simon's Rock as a first-year student and begin your college career in a community of peers—students your age who share an intense appetite for learning. The Princeton Review rates academics at Simon's Rock higher than those at Harvard and Princeton. Our alumni are Fulbright Fellows, Rhodes Scholars, and MacArthur Genius Grant recipients. They are innovators and game changers making their mark in finance, the arts, literature, politics, academia, and science, often while still in their 20s.


WHAT PARENTS SHOULD KNOW

FINANCIAL AID


At Bard Academy, most of our students—about 80%—receive financial aid. (Students are also eligible for federal financial aid once they enter the College.)
