Math Competition Every year undergraduates across North

Rockers Rank High in Prestigious

America take the William Lowell Putnam Exam, the most prestigious Mathematics competition exam in the United States and Canada. This past December, 4,229 students from 488



different institutions took the very challenging exam, attempting to answer 12 questions across two 3-hour exam sessions. The median score was 2 out of 120, and the most common score was 0, both results being typical for the exam. Six Simon's Rock students participated, and each scored at least 1 point; in fact, five of the six students scored 9 points or better! Rocker Daniel Cui led the team, scoring 24 points, ranking 384th in the country! Congratulations to all of them!
